Posting WIC checks, foods, baby formula, or breast pumps for sale in newspapers *OR* on the Internet is **FRAUD**. This includes:

- Craig's List
- Facebook
- Twitter
- eBay
- Any other social media outlet

Giving away WIC checks, foods, baby formula, or breast pumps OR selling them for cash is **FRAUD**.

## WHAT CAN YOU DO IF YOU SUSPECT FRAUD?

If you suspect that someone may be committing **FRAUD**, please contact the Bureau of Special Investigations (BSI). You may report your concerns anonymously.



Reporting false income, household size *OR* pregnancy to become eligible to participate in WIC is **FRAUD**.






